# INDIA'S TEXTILE INDUSTRY

## BRIDGING THE GAP WITH CHINA, VIETNAM, AND BANGLADESH THROUGH INNOVATION

The Indian textile industry, once a dominant global force, now faces significant challenges amidst rising international competition. Despite its rich heritage and vast manufacturing capacity, India struggles to match the speed, scale, and technological advancements of countries like China, Vietnam, and Bangladesh.

However, the industry stands at a turning point. With renewed focus on innovation, research, and development, India has the potential to reclaim its leadership. Offering valuable insights into this transformation is Mr. Thanveer Ahmed, President – Raw Materials and Sourcing at Eastman Exports, a leading figure in the textile sector.

With over 40 years of experience in the textile and apparel industry, Mr. Thanveer Ahmed has worked across the entire textile value chain—from spinning and fabric inspection to global sourcing and raw material development. He has held key positions at renowned global brands like Gap, Target, Mast Industries, and Ralph Lauren, before joining Eastman Exports.

His extensive knowledge of quality control, product development, and sourcing operations across India, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, and beyond makes his perspective particularly relevant in today's dynamic textile landscape.

### India's Position in the Global Textile Market

Reflecting on his career, Mr. Ahmed recalls the pre-2005 quota regime when global trade restrictions limited exports from each country. Even under those constraints, India held a respectable position. However, in the current quota-free world, India lags behind in efficiency, scale, and coordination, especially compared to countries like China, Bangladesh, and Vietnam.

He recounts a striking example: “Once, I needed 1 million yards of linen dyed and delivered urgently. Chinese mills fulfilled it within a week. That kind of responsiveness is still unthinkable in India,” he says. “Our operations remain fragmented, and there's a lack of collective responsibility. If I quote ₹500, someone will quote ₹450 even if it's a loss. That mindset hurts us.”

### The Reliability Gap

One key reason why international buyers prefer China is reliability. “In China, quality is consistent, timelines are met, and operations are smooth,” says Mr. Ahmed. “In India, you often have to fight for quality and struggle to meet deadlines.”

He also points to infrastructural disadvantages. “In Vietnam, a container can cover 600 kilometers in 8–10 hours. In India, the same might take up to 8 days for just 2,000 kilometers.” Such logistical delays hinder India's competitiveness and encourage brands to localize sourcing in faster economies.



## Learning from Vietnam and Bangladesh

Mr. Ahmed holds deep admiration for countries like Vietnam, Bangladesh, and Cambodia, which have emerged as global textile leaders despite their smaller size. He recalls visiting Bangladesh in the 1980s when it was still struggling—and now, it hosts some of the world's largest platinum-certified factories.

Their progress stems from a disciplined labor force, technological adoption, and strong infrastructure. “If I had to settle outside India, I would choose Vietnam,” he remarks, emphasizing their efficiency and future-ready ecosystem.

## Generational Shifts and Missed Opportunities

Another major concern is the generational shift in India's textile sector. Many second-generation business owners are moving away from the textile trade, leaving established export houses without successors.

India has also missed key global opportunities, particularly during disruptions like the COVID-19 pandemic, due to slow coordination and poor decision-making. “The drive to invest and innovate must come from within the industry,” says Mr. Ahmed. “Our societal attitude needs to change.”

## A Future Driven by Technology

Despite the challenges, Mr. Ahmed is optimistic. Eastman Exports is investing heavily in AI-powered fabric inspection machines, which drastically reduce human error and increase productivity. “Earlier, we had to wait for manual checks. Now, real-time digital feedback flags errors instantly—it's a game-changer,” he explains.

They are also adopting AI-enabled knitting machines that allow for instant correction of defects. Such digital transformation signals a new era for Indian manufacturing.

## Balancing Automation with Employment

While automation reduces the number of workers needed—spinning mills that once employed 600 now run with 150—Mr. Ahmed believes it creates demand for skilled labor. “Education and exposure are critical. The younger generation must travel, visit factories, and learn. Without a change in mindset, transformation won't happen,” he says.

## Smarter Sourcing and Sustainable Innovation

Eastman's sourcing strategy blends long-term supplier partnerships with openness to emerging innovations. Their R&D team is exploring future-ready solutions like cationic yarns, recycled fibers, and specialized blends that improve sustainability and performance.

This continuous innovation helps Eastman stay ahead in a fast-evolving industry landscape.

## Looking Ahead: Capacity and Vision

Mr. Ahmed concludes by stressing the need for capacity building and long-term vision. India must invest in expanding manufacturing operations, improving infrastructure, and training its workforce. These efforts are essential to compete globally.

## The Road Ahead for Indian Textiles

India's textile industry holds immense promise—but only if it embraces innovation, upgrades infrastructure, and invests in people. As Mr. Ahmed aptly puts it, “Innovation brings quality. If adopted at the right time, it changes the game.”

India's textile story is far from over. To write its next chapter, the industry must channel fresh ideas, bold investments, and future-focused strategies.

Additionally, hemp is lightweight and breathable, making it ideal for hot climates. It helps moisture evaporate from the skin, keeping you cool and comfortable.

Growing hemp also offers broader environmental benefits. One hectare of hemp plants can absorb up to 22 tons of carbon dioxide—

more than most forests. It grows quickly, taking only 90–120 days to harvest. This rapid growth helps combat global warming while providing farmers with quick returns. Recognizing these advantages, Indian states such as Uttarakhand have legalized hemp farming, with Himachal Pradesh expected to follow suit soon.

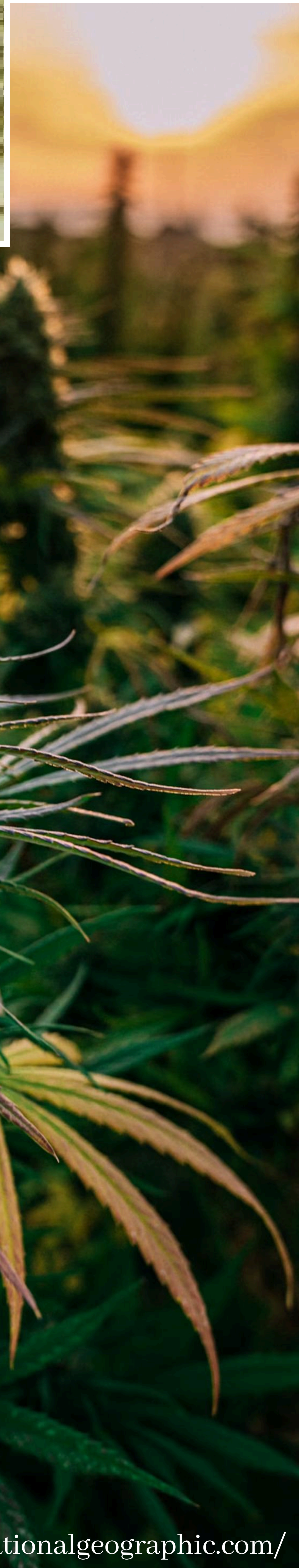
### Versatility

Hemp's potential goes far beyond apparel. It is used to make tote bags, travel accessories, home furnishings like curtains and bedsheets, as well as strong ropes, paper, biofuels, and eco-friendly plastics. This wide range of applications is attracting interest from industries including fashion, interior design, home décor, and industrial goods.

### The Challenge

Despite these advantages, hemp still faces hurdles. Currently, hemp fabric is about six to seven times more expensive than cotton and approximately 15% costlier than linen. This is largely because hemp farming is not yet widespread. However, as more Indian farmers adopt hemp cultivation, prices are expected to fall—similar to how bamboo fabric, once a premium material, is now widely affordable.





## Market Growth

Globally, the hemp market has grown rapidly in recent years, driven by increasing demand for sustainable products. Valued at USD 10.78 billion, it is projected to reach USD 82.05 billion by 2033, with a growth rate of 22.5%. In India, the hemp industry reached USD 97.3 million in 2022 and is projected to grow to USD 417.6 million by 2025, with a 20% growth rate. As more brands prioritize sustainability, demand for hemp in India is expected to surge.

## From Textile Legacy to Hemp Pioneer: The Journey of Weaving Vibes

To gain deeper insights into the future of hemp fabric, we spoke with Mr. Shripat Jagirdhar, founder of Weaving Vibes, a Mumbai-based sustainable textile startup focused on hemp. Drawing from his family's three-decade legacy in textiles, Mr. Jagirdhar shared his journey, challenges, and vision for hemp in India.



Could you share your journey into the hemp textile industry?

**Shripat Jagirdhar:** My journey into hemp textiles wasn't a straight line; it has been both challenging and exciting. Coming from a family with over 30 years in the textile business, fabric runs in my blood. But I didn't want to simply continue the legacy—I wanted to evolve it. Hemp stood out not just for its sustainability but for its untapped potential in India. That led to the birth of Weaving Vibes. The experience so far? Equal parts exhilarating and exhausting. At Weaving Vibes, we're building something future-forward, and that vision keeps me motivated.

My prior hands-on experience in the family textile business gave me a strong technical foundation in weaving, spinning, and production. More importantly, it helped me understand where the gaps were—particularly regarding sustainability. You can't disrupt an industry unless you truly understand how it works first.

## Hemp's Unique Edge: Sustainability, Durability, and Usability

How does hemp compare with conventional fabrics like cotton or polyester?

**Shripat Jagirdhar:** Hemp is truly nature's overachiever. From a sustainability standpoint, it uses much less water than cotton, requires no pesticides, and actually improves the soil. But beyond that, it is incredibly practical. Hemp is one of the most durable natural fibers available—it wears in, not out. The more you use it, the softer it becomes.

When it comes to summer wear, hemp truly shines. It's naturally breathable with excellent moisture-wicking properties, keeping you cool in the heat. Plus, it's antimicrobial and UV-resistant, making it ideal for tropical climates like India. Thanks to advancements in processing, hemp has moved beyond its rough image into the realm of lightweight, elegant, everyday fabrics. It's comfort with a conscience.

## Overcoming Challenges and Shifting Perceptions

What were the biggest challenges in promoting hemp in India?

**Shripat Jagirdhar:** The biggest challenge is perception. Many people still associate hemp with its controversial cousin, cannabis, so education is key. Supply chain hurdles—such as sourcing quality raw materials, acquiring the right machinery, and training staff—also pose challenges. Then there's the price: hemp is a premium fabric, so convincing buyers it's worth the investment takes effort.

That said, we are at a tipping point. While hemp isn't mainstream yet, it's no longer on the fringes. We are seeing high-end designers and conscious direct-to-consumer brands increasingly turn to hemp. The industry recognizes the need for sustainable alternatives, and hemp is now a viable contender.

## Market Dynamics and Consumer Behavior

How can hemp become more affordable? Who is your target market?

**Shripat Jagirdhar:** Scale is key. The more we grow, process, and manufacture hemp, the more affordable it will become. Government support, subsidies, and incentives for sustainable farming would also help.

Blending hemp with other sustainable fibers is another smart route, and we're actively pursuing this strategy.

Our core buyers are high-end designers and sustainable fashion brands—people who value impact and are willing to experiment. Consumer behavior is evolving. Today's shoppers are more curious, informed, and environmentally conscious. However, they need compelling storytelling and transparency to connect with hemp. Once they do, they rarely look back.

## Innovations in Hemp Fabric Production

What innovations are shaping hemp fabric production?

**Shripat Jagirdhar:** Innovation is thriving. We are exploring enzymatic softening processes and blending hemp with fibers like Tencel, bamboo, and organic cotton. We are also adopting sustainable dyeing techniques that reduce water and chemical usage. New weaving technologies are helping us create finer, more luxurious textures. We are actively debunking the myth that hemp cannot be elegant.

## The Regulatory Landscape

What limits hemp cultivation in India, and how does India compare globally?

**Shripat Jagirdhar:** There is too much red tape. Although industrial hemp contains negligible THC, its association with cannabis slows policy decisions. Farmers face low awareness, poor access to quality seeds, and minimal infrastructure. A clearer legal framework and proactive government support could change everything.

Globally, countries like China and European nations lead in scale, technology, and policy. India lags behind but holds immense potential. We need fast-tracked legal approvals, investment in R&D, farmer incentives, and stronger industry-academic partnerships. With the right ecosystem, India could lead in quality, sustainability, and textile diversity.

## Scaling Up and the Future

Can hemp replace cotton or polyester at scale? What drives its growth, especially in exports?

**Shripat Jagirdhar:** Hemp can become a serious contender. While it may not replace cotton or polyester overnight, its advantages make it a key player in the future of textiles. The future lies in conscious material combinations—not one fiber replacing another. Hemp will move beyond niche markets, especially in workwear, denim, and home textiles. The challenge is scale, not potential.



Global demand for sustainable textiles is surging. Markets like the US, UK, Germany, Australia, Japan, Korea, and the UAE are shifting toward eco-conscious sourcing. India's low-cost production base and rich textile heritage make it well-positioned to capitalize on this trend. The narrative of hemp—from a 'forbidden' plant to a fabric of the future—is helping open international doors.

### Weaving Vibes' Vision

**What is the next big milestone for the hemp industry? What's next for Weaving Vibes?**

**Shripat Jagirdhar:** The next big milestone will be regulatory clarity, mainstream cultivation rights, and government-backed R&D. Technological breakthroughs—such as bio-composites and hemp-based performance textiles—will revolutionize the space. Hemp is poised to go beyond fabric; it could power building materials, car interiors, and more.

At Weaving Vibes, we are collaborating on a capsule collection with a designer label that champions sustainable fashion. On the B2B side, we are expanding our swatch library with low minimum order quantities and ready-to-ship options to make hemp accessible to brands of all sizes. Excitingly, we are moving toward a full "fiber-to-fashion" journey using premium A1-grade New Zealand hemp fibers. We aim to set new benchmarks in quality and consistency, especially as we scale our home furnishing offerings. This is just the beginning.

Hemp fabric represents a sustainable, durable, and versatile future for textiles. With minimal environmental impact, exceptional strength, and broad adaptability, hemp proves that fashion and sustainability can go hand in hand. Industry pioneers like Weaving Vibes are leading this transformation, helping unlock hemp's potential in India and beyond.

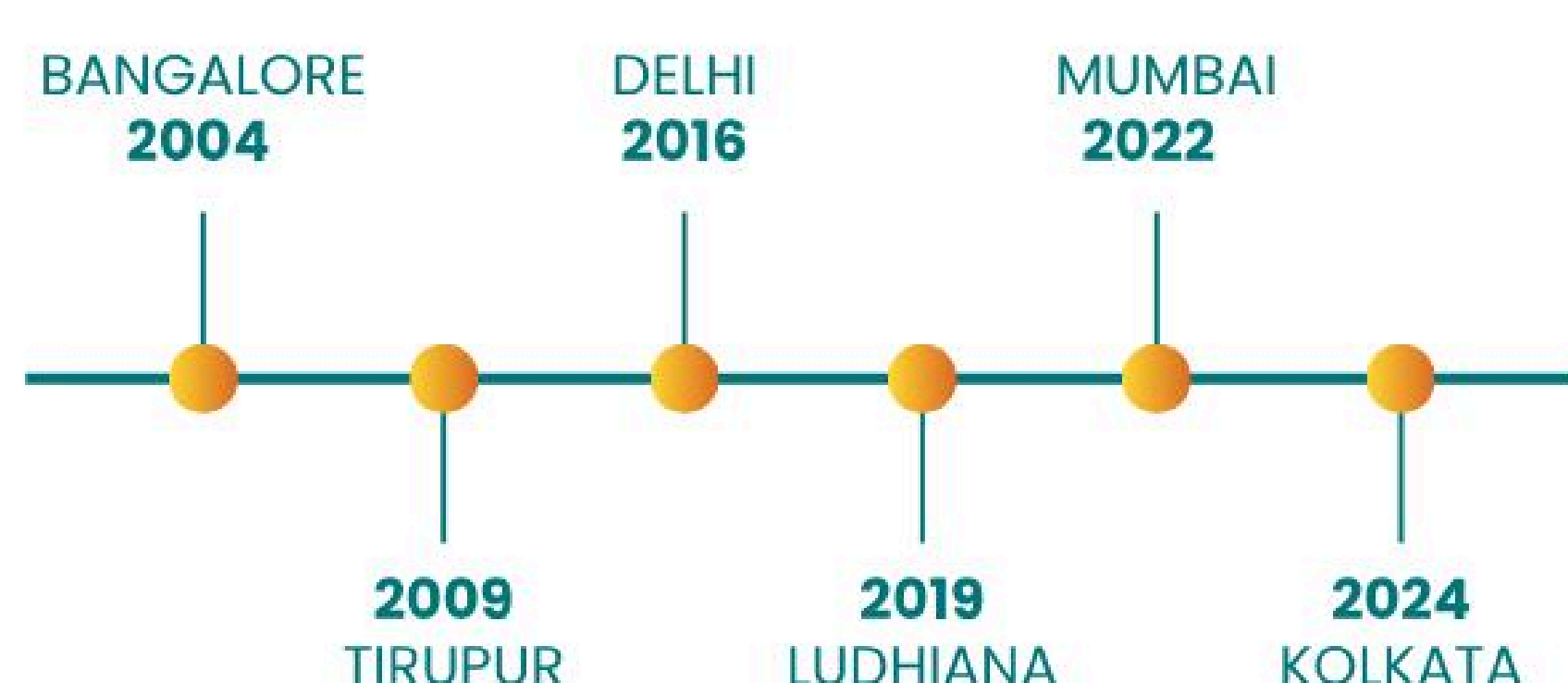
